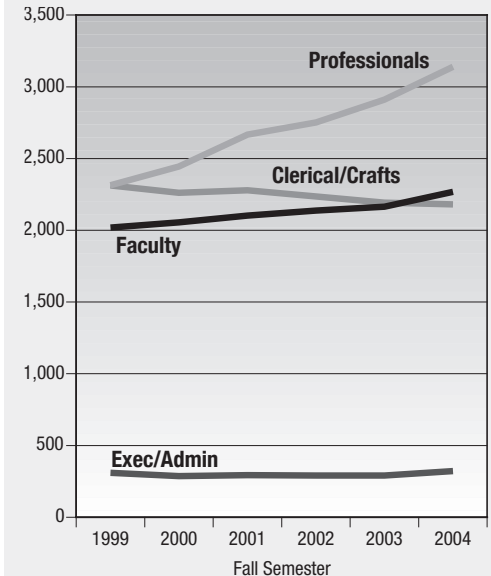

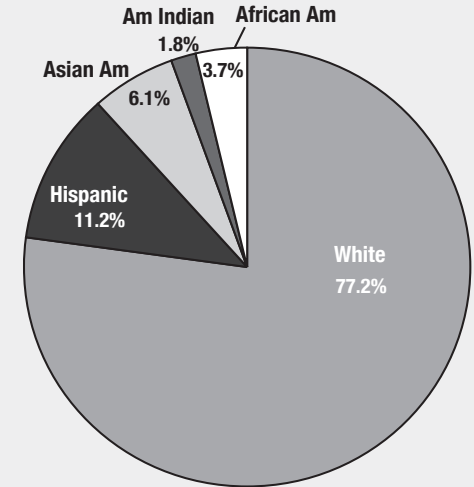

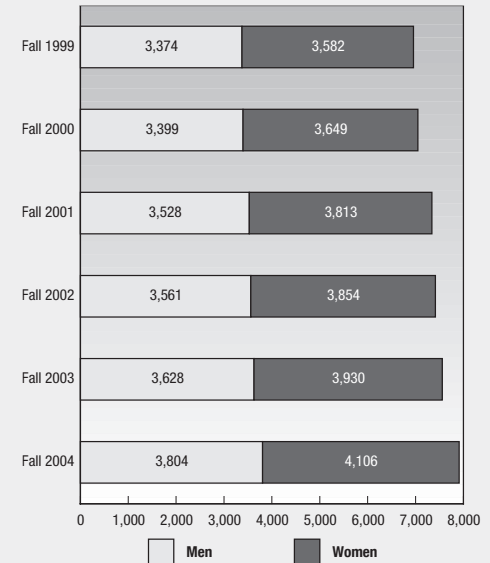

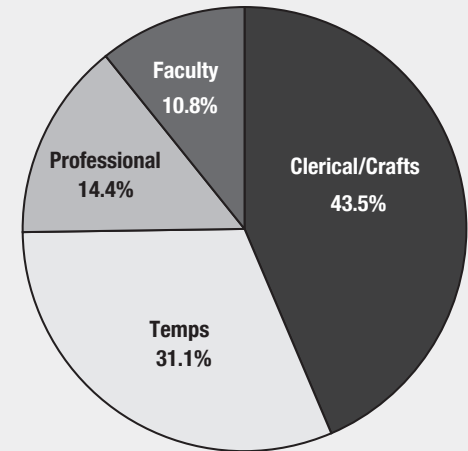

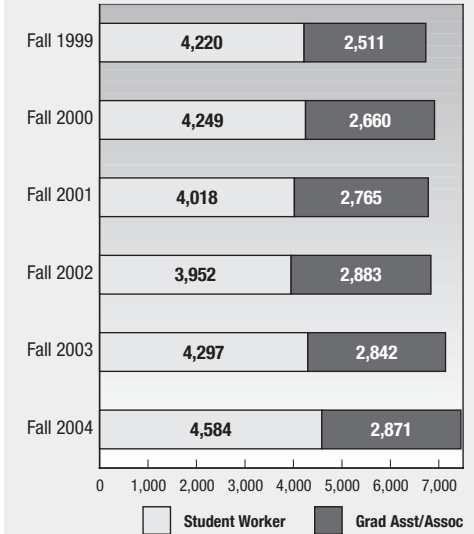

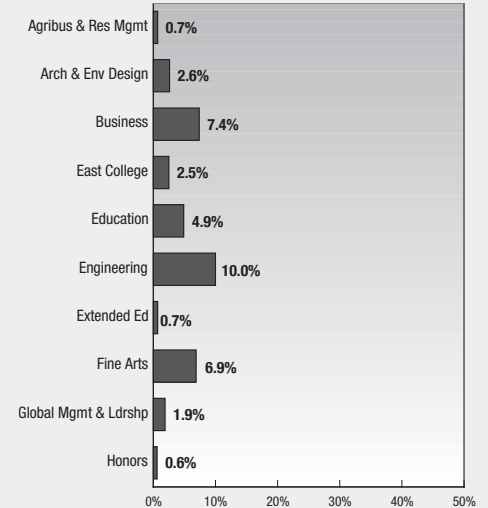

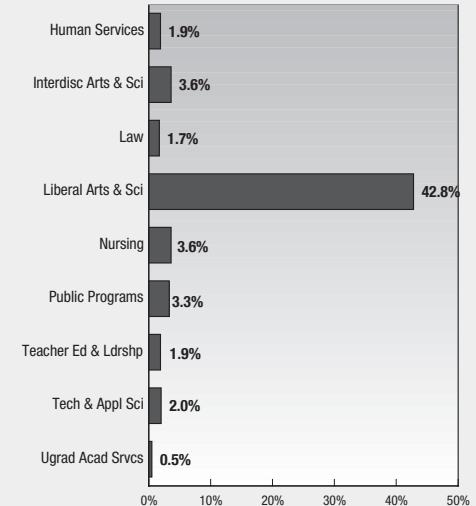

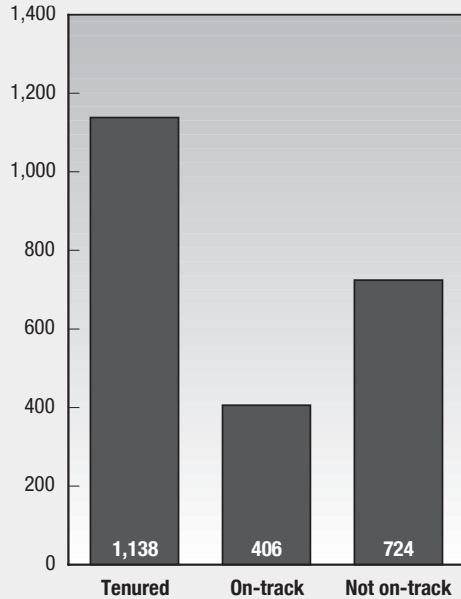
### Fall 2004 College Representation

Fall 2004 Tenure Status



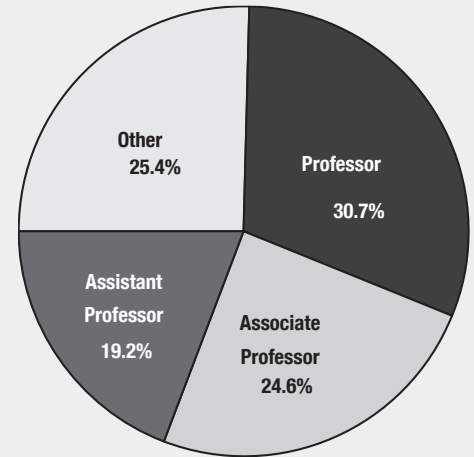
