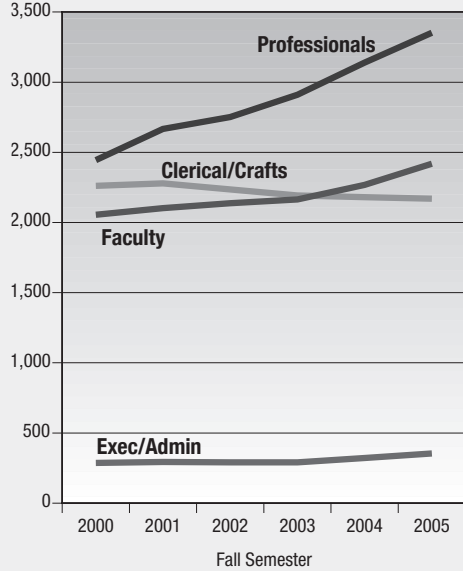

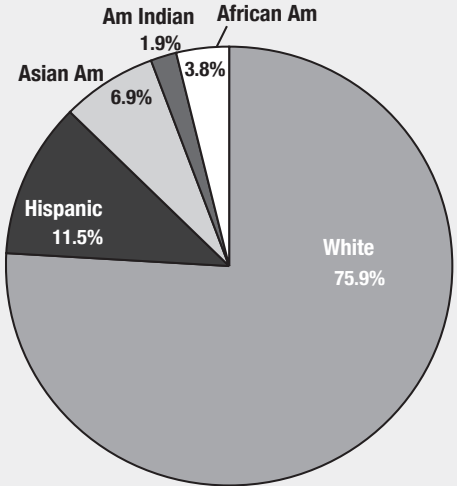

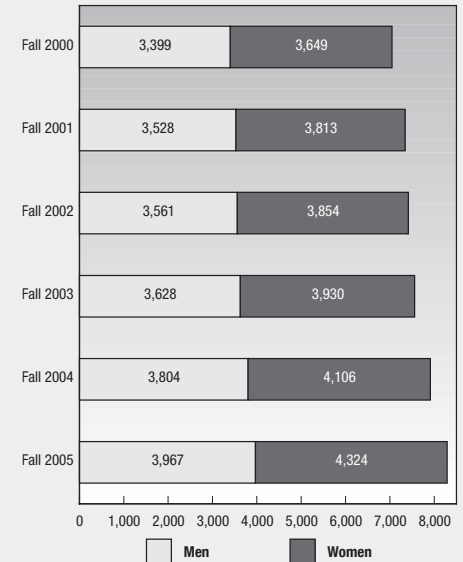

### Five-year Trend



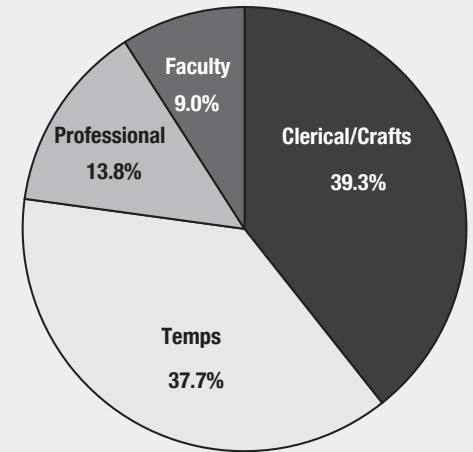

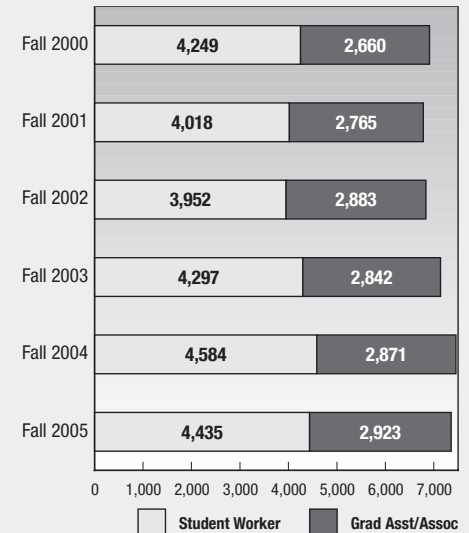

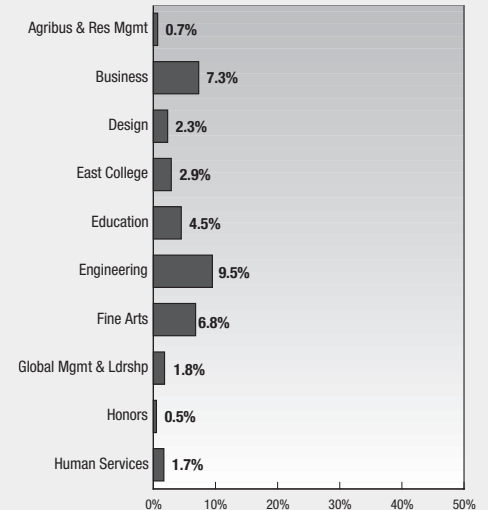

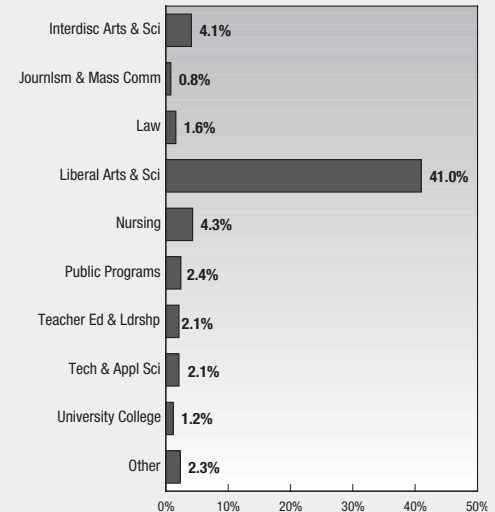

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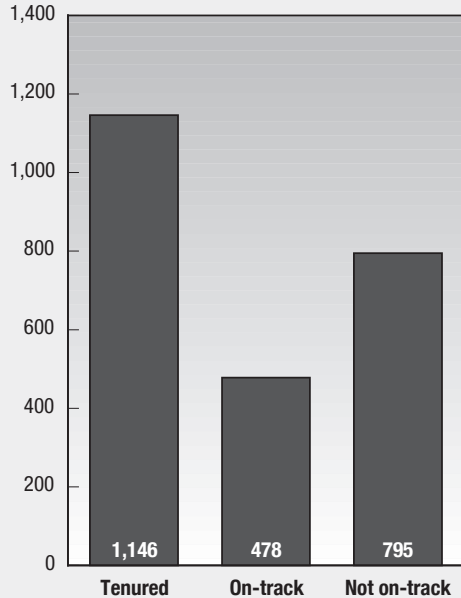
### Fall 2005 College Representation

Fall 2005 Tenure Status



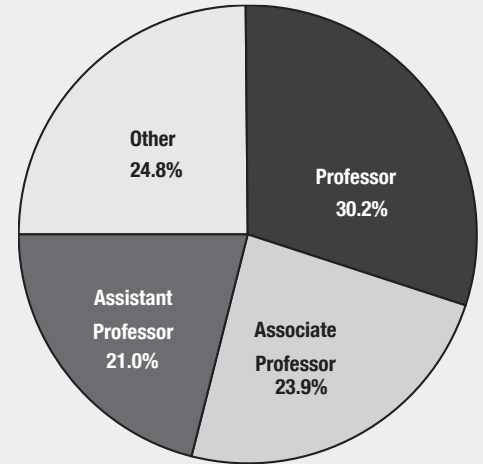
