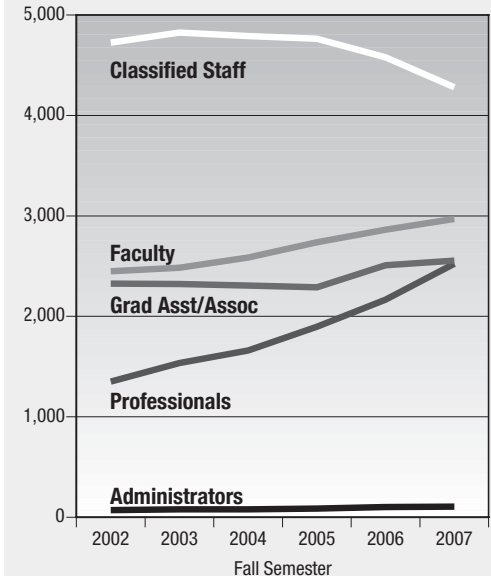

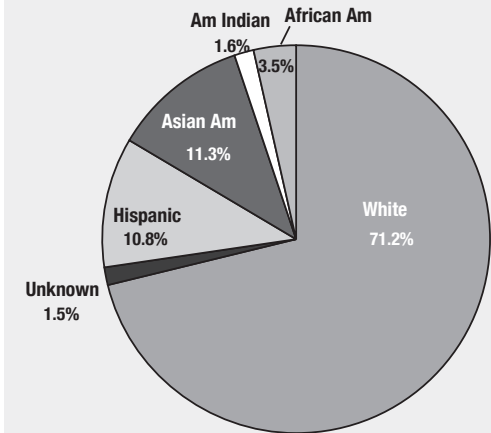

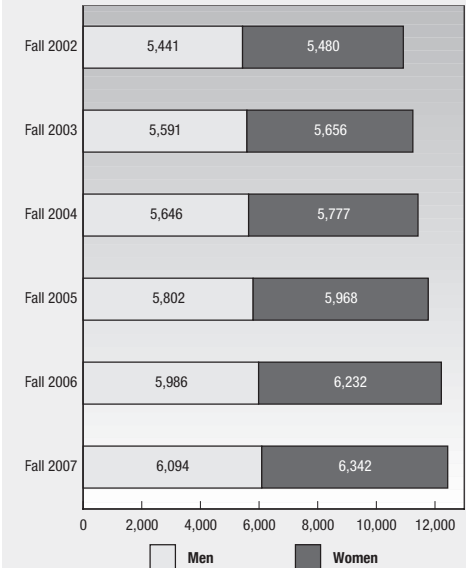

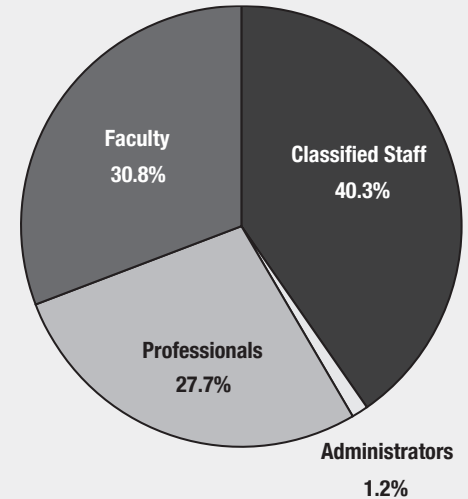

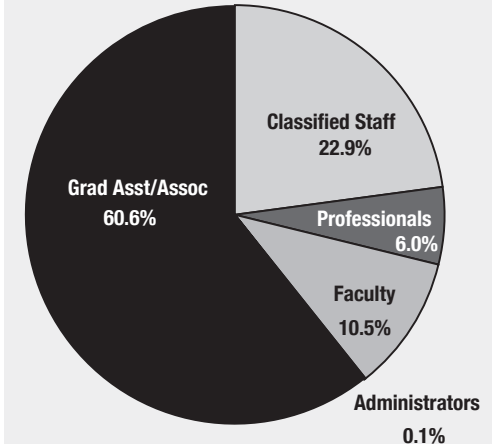

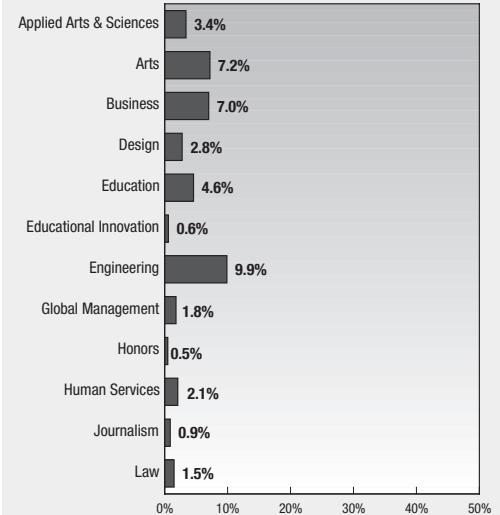

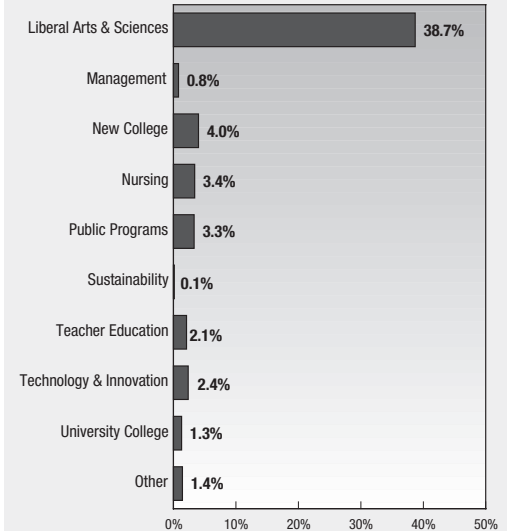

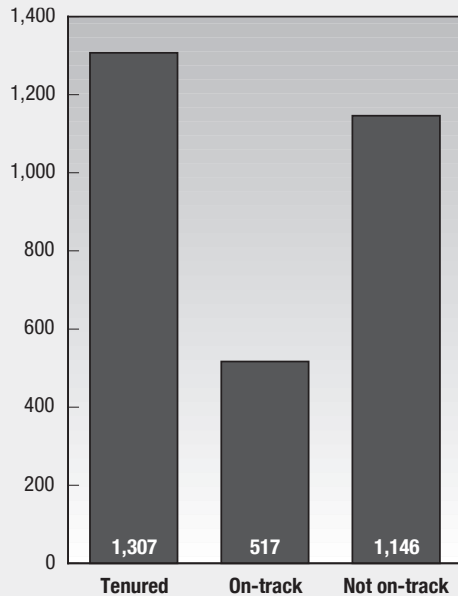
Fall 2007 College Representation

Fall 2007 Tenure Status

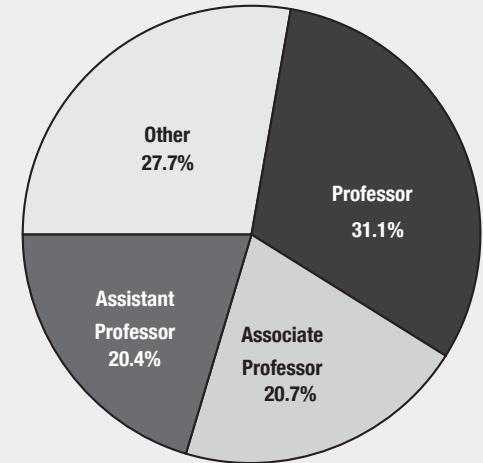
