

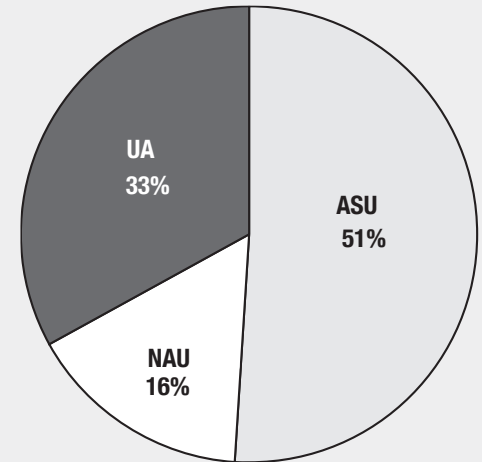

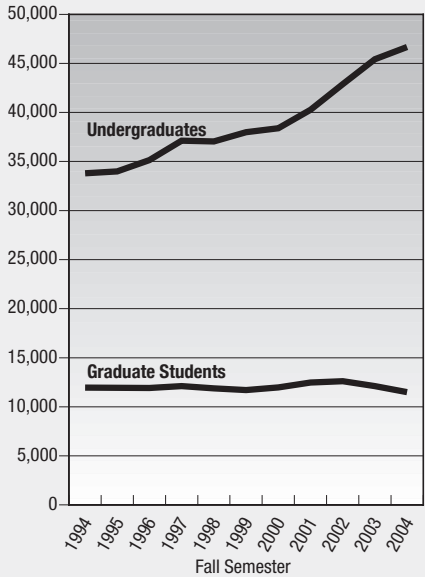

### Ten-year Trend



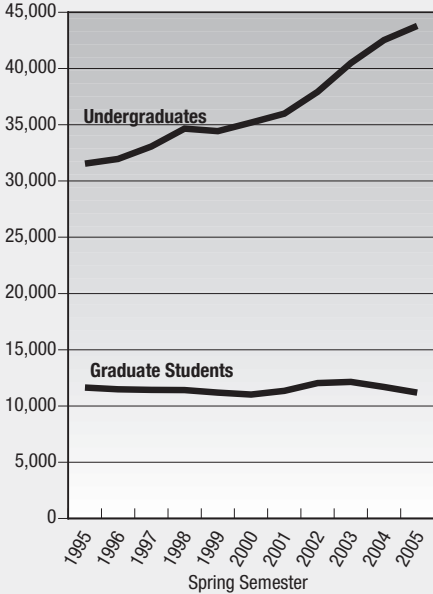

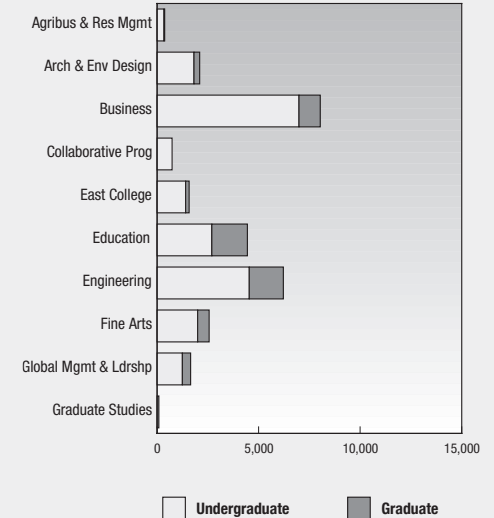

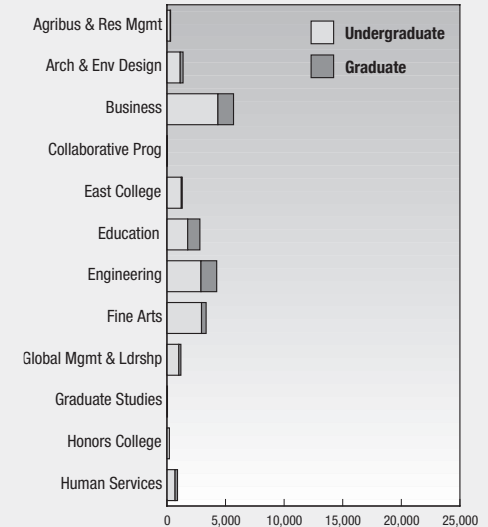

### Fall 2004 FTE — 53,873



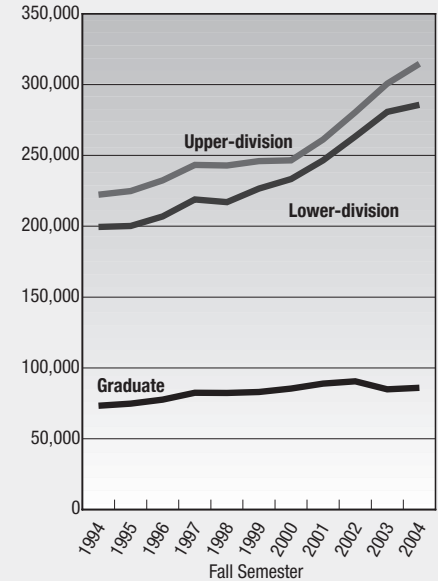

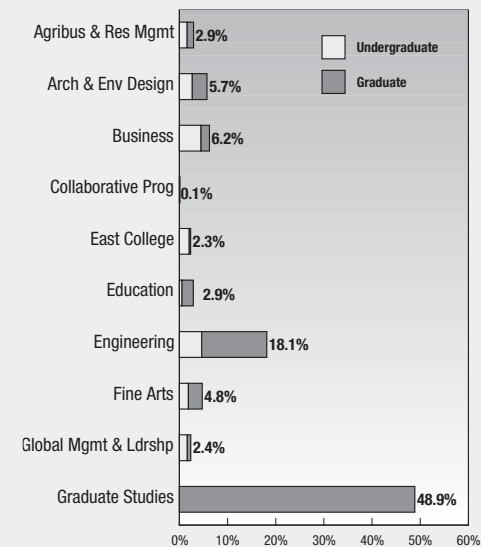

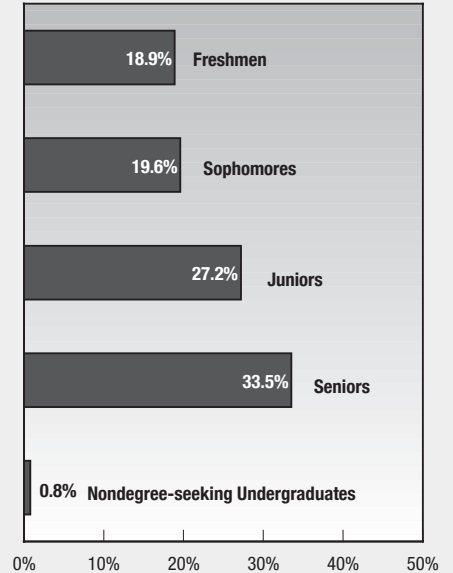

### Undergraduate Distribution by Level



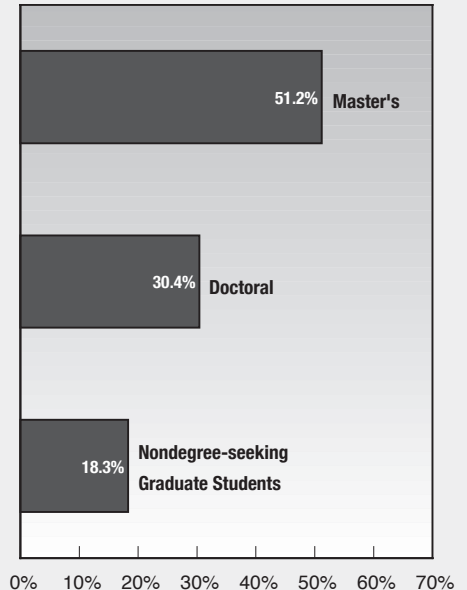

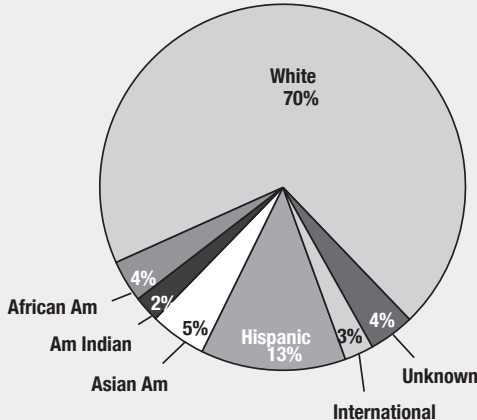

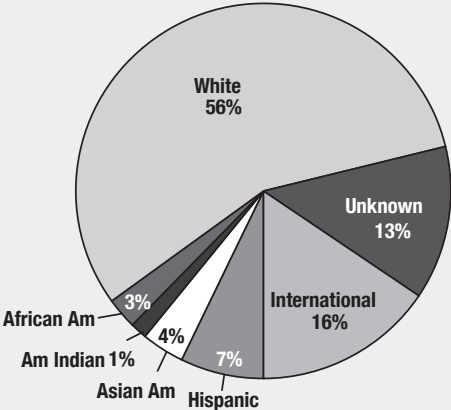

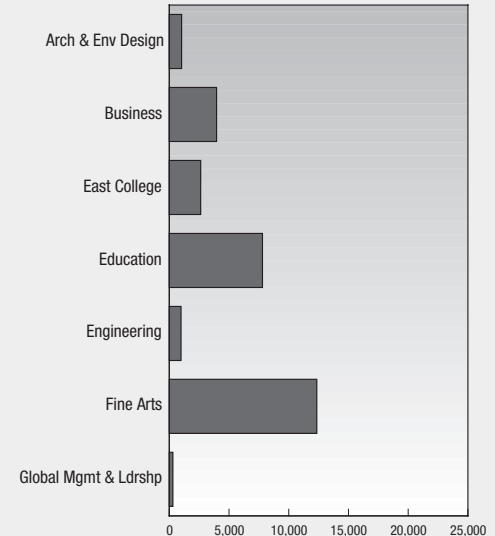

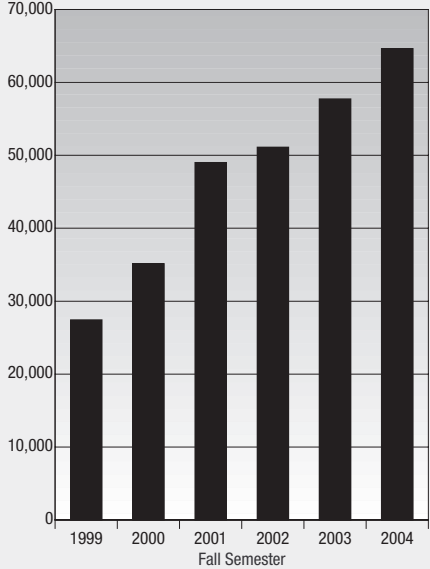

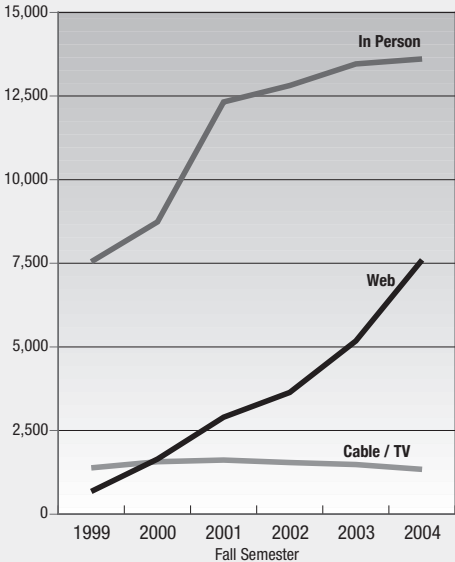
