Before Using the Enrollment Summary

What is the Enrollment Summary?

The <u>Enrollment Summary</u> is an official publication of Arizona State University. It provides information about student enrollment and credit hours. Data are from the official 21st day enrollment reported to the Arizona Board of Regents and are presented for each college and academic unit to assist academic administrators in planning and evaluation.

What information does the Enrollment Summary contain?

The <u>Enrollment Summary</u> contains the following summaries for each college and academic unit.

- Number of Students by Student Level
- Number of Part-Time and Full-Time Students
- Number of Students by Ethnicity and Gender
- Number of Resident and Non-Resident Students
- Number of New Undergraduate Students by Academic Level at Entry (freshman, transfer, etc.)
- Student Credit Hours and Full-Time Equivalents
- A djusted Student Credit Hours and Full-Time Equivalents (see "Student Credit Hours (SCH)" comments.)
- Distribution of Student Load by College (i.e., Student enrollment in colleges)

How is a student's college and academic unit determined?

Student data are reported in academic units based on the fourdigit major code that represents the student's major field of study. The curriculum code table, which is maintained by the Registrar, aligns each major with an academic unit. ASU's General Catalog and the Regents' approved program inventory are the primary sources for this table.

How are students credit hours (SCH) and fulltime equivalents (FTE) allocated to academic units?

The allocation of student credit hours to academic units is presented in two separate tables. First, SCH are allocated to the academic unit offering the course. These data are presented in the table, "Student Credit Hours and Full-Time Equivalents," and do not reflect the funding source of the instructor. The second table, "Adjusted Student Credit Hours and Full-Time Equivalents," reflects an allocation of SCH based on the academic unit funding the course instructor. This allocation method was introduced to properly allocate the student credit hours generated in interdisciplinary courses.

Before Using the Enrollment Summary

The Adjusted SCH table reflects corrections in course assignments for faculty teaching courses outside their home department. These adjustments are collected during the Departmental Course Update process. The adjustment allocates SCH to the department funding the course. In a few cases, this adjustment results in SCH credited to Tempe from West. In most cases, there is little or no difference between the SCH and Adjusted SCH tables.

The College of Extended Education

The <u>Enrollment Summary</u> includes enrollment tables for the College of Extended Education. The enrollment and credit hour data shown in these tables are reported within the colleges tables also.
