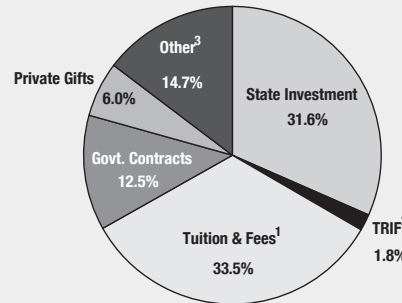

2007–08 Revenues

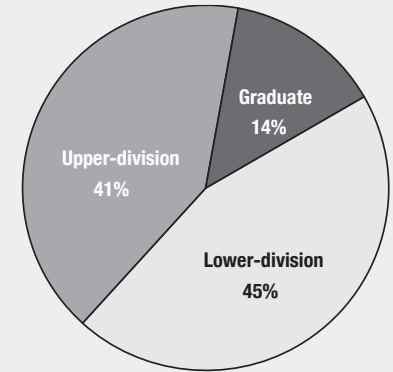
