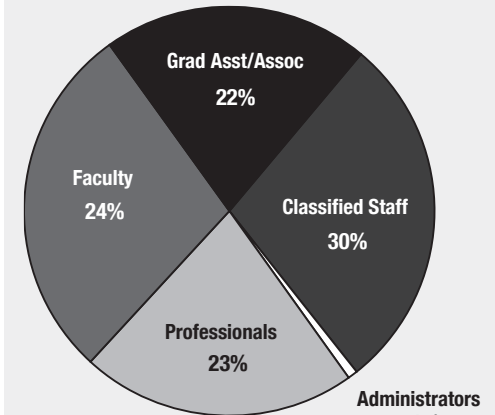

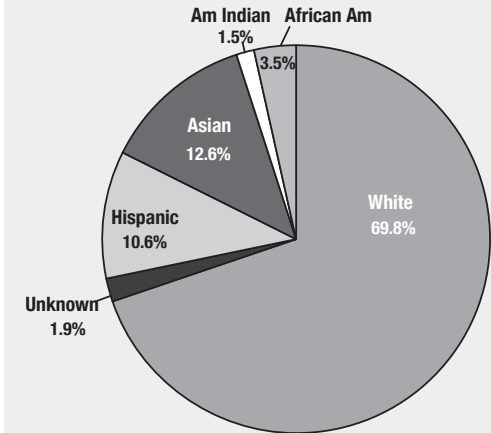

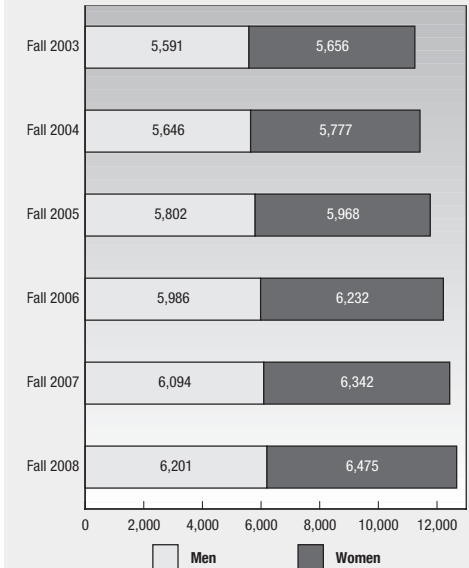

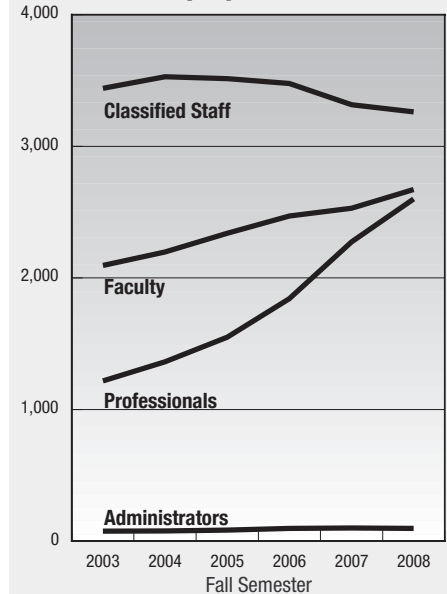

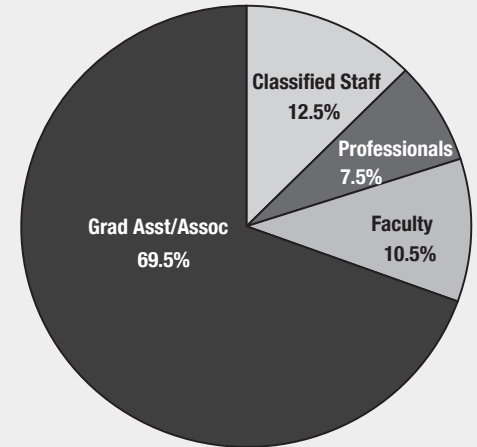

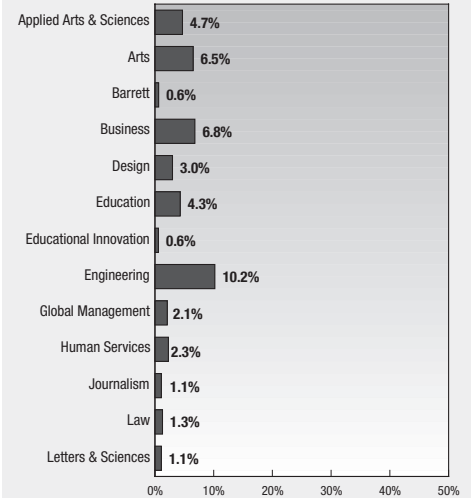

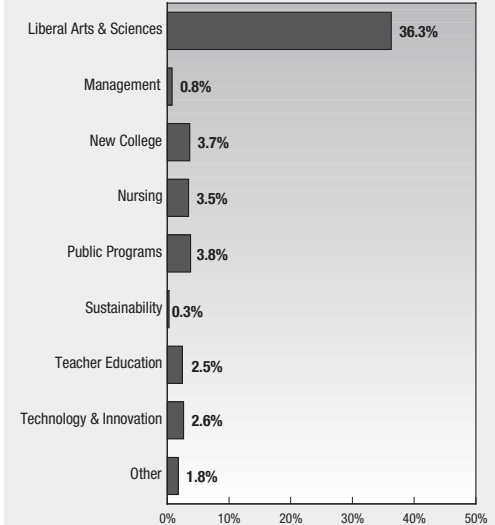

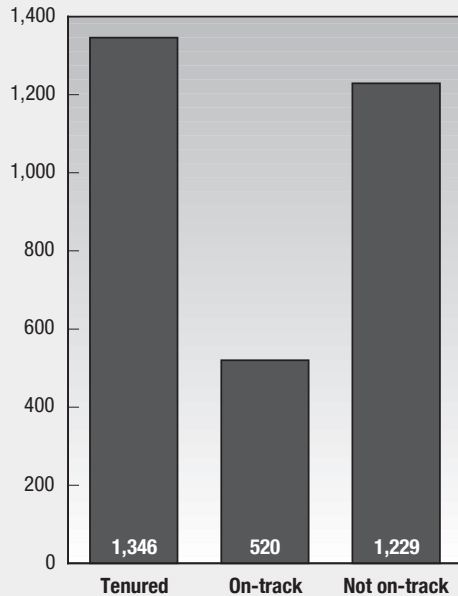
Fall 2008 College Representation

Fall 2008 Tenure Status

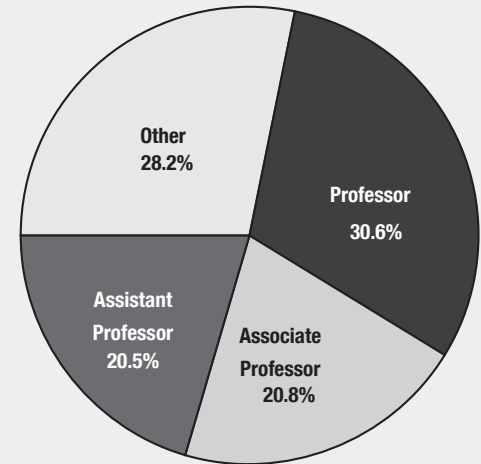
