

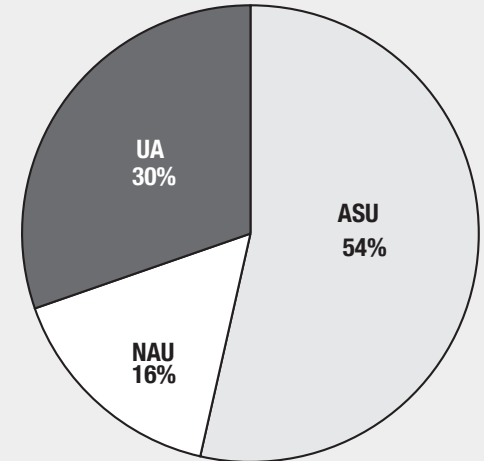

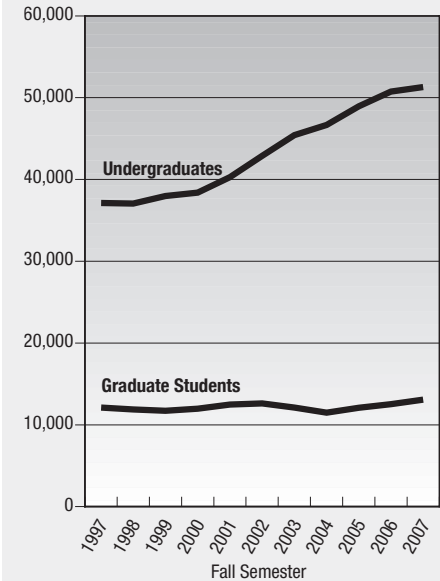

### Ten-year Trend



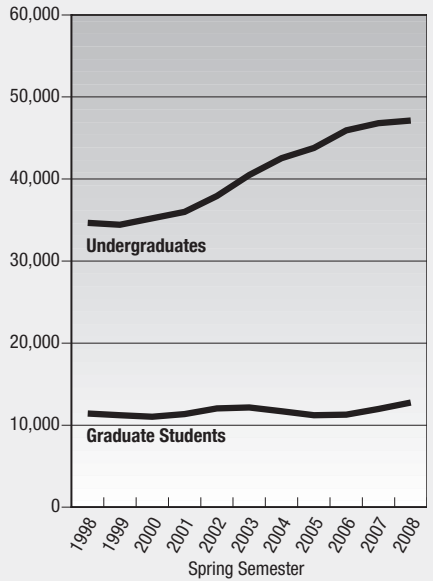

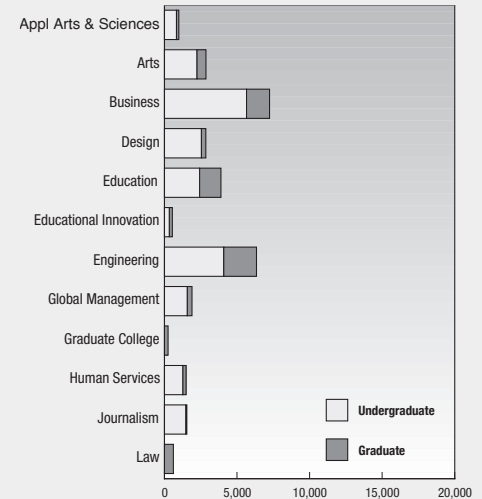

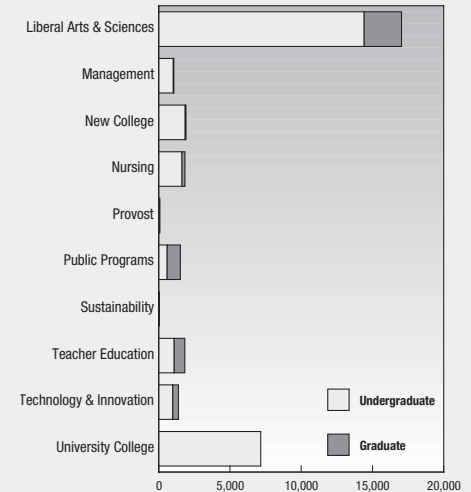

### Fall 2007 Enrollment — 64,394



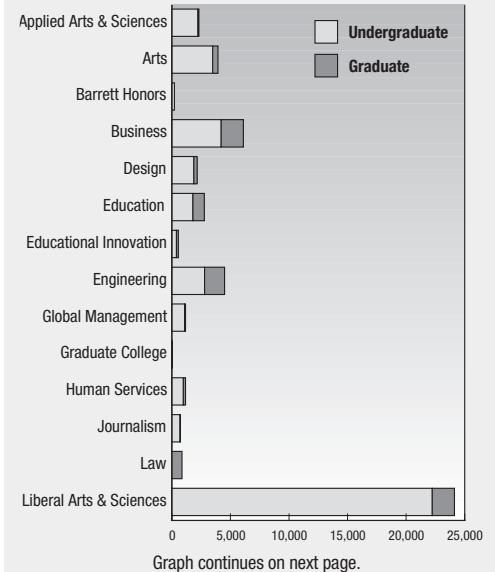

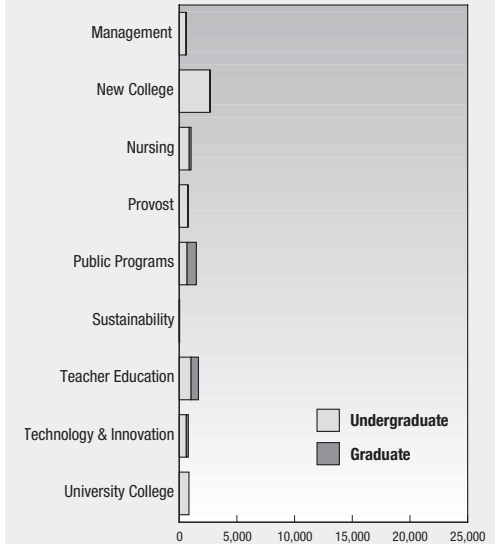

### Fall 2007 FTE — 60,543



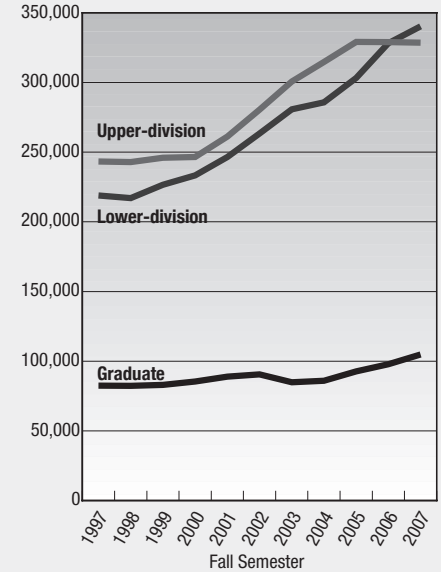

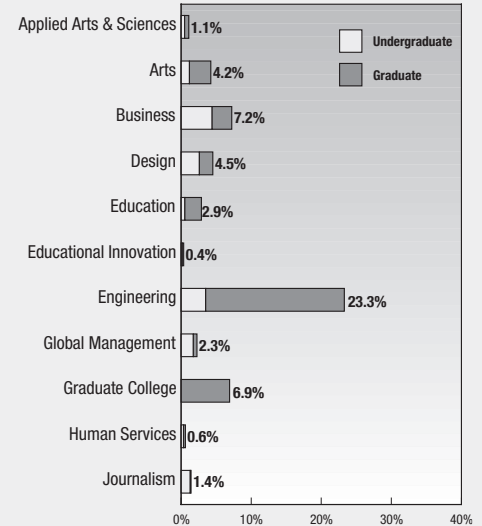

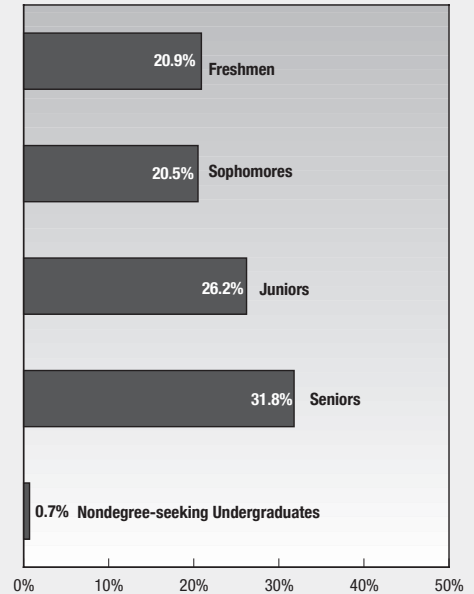

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### Undergraduate Distribution by Level



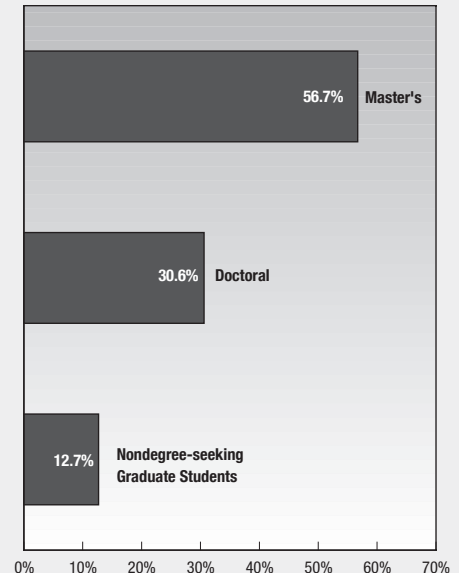

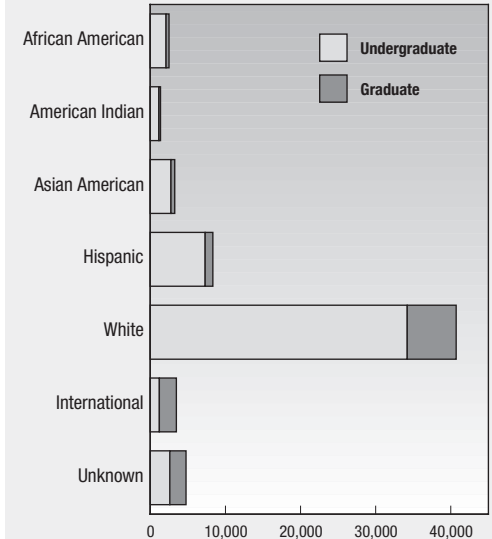

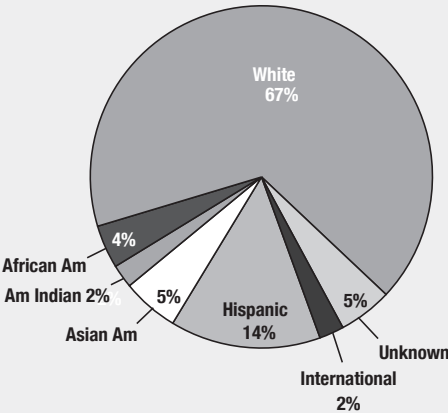

## Enrollment by Race/Ethnicity

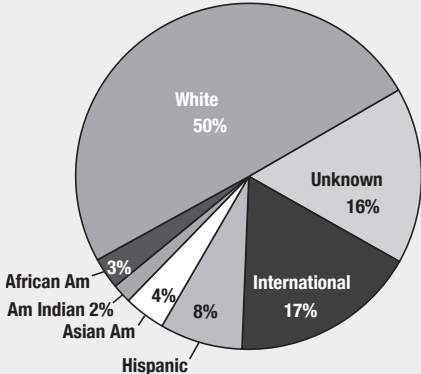
Fall 2007 Undergraduate Distribution
