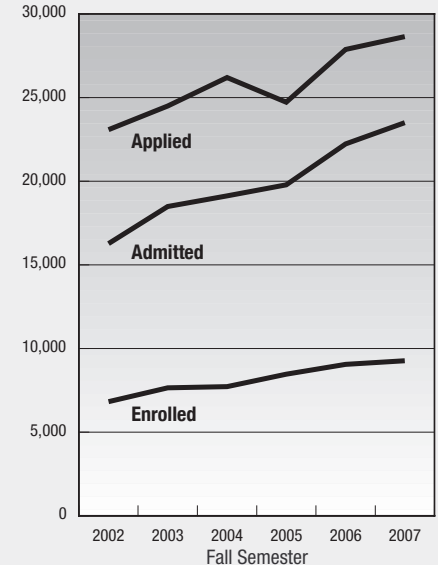

Freshmen Five-Year Trend



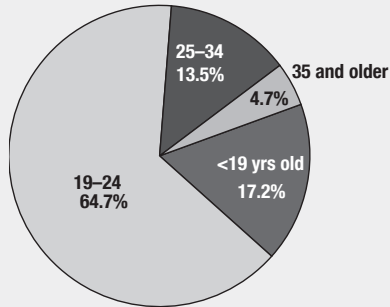

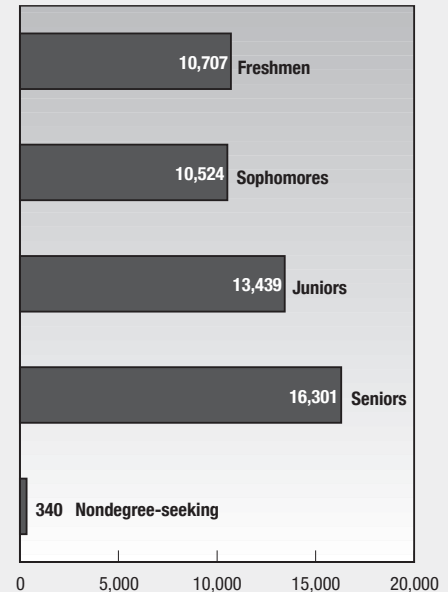

Enrollment by Level



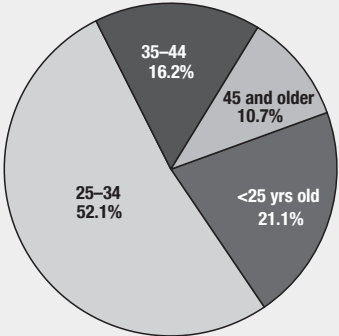

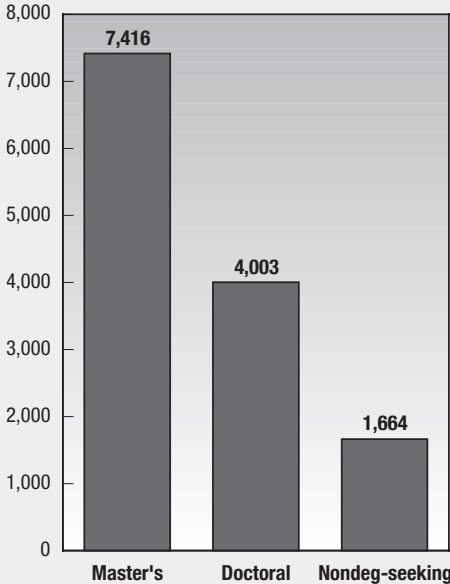

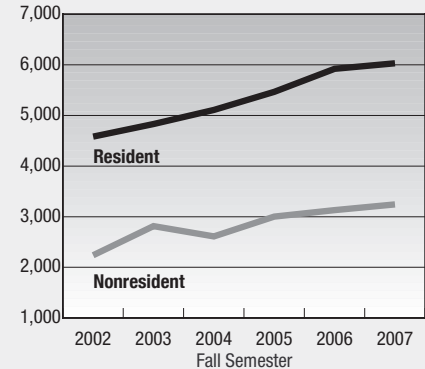

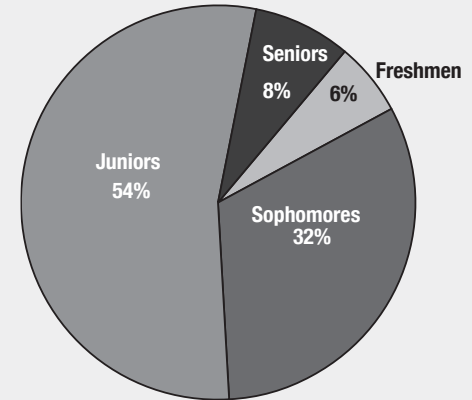

Fall 2007 Distribution by Level

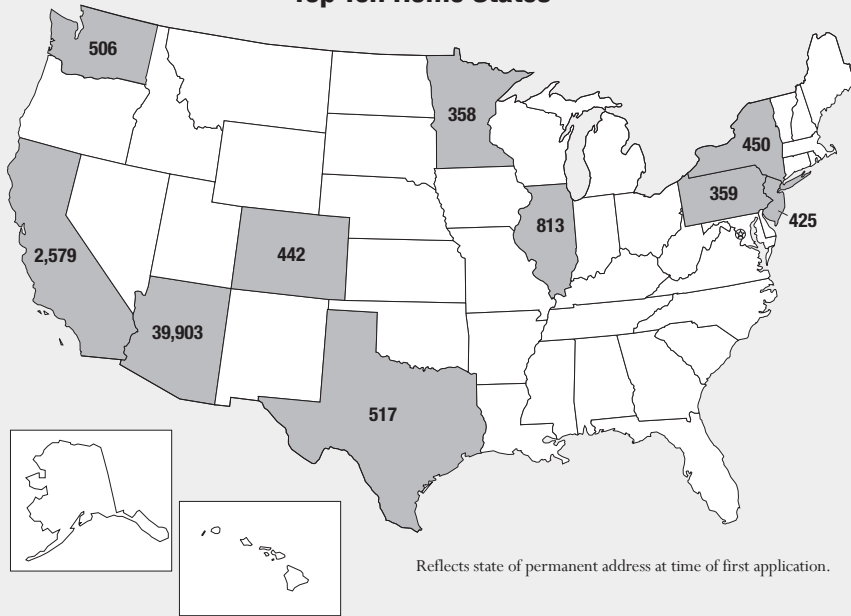

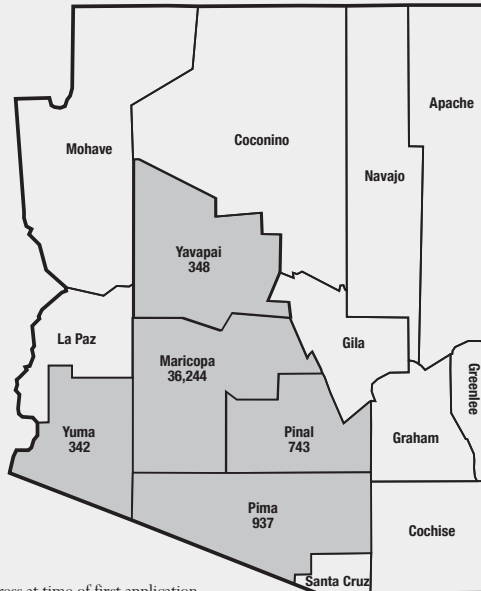

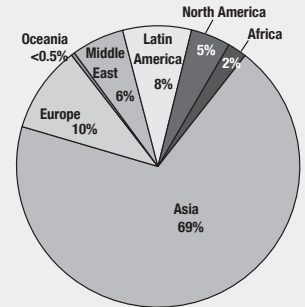

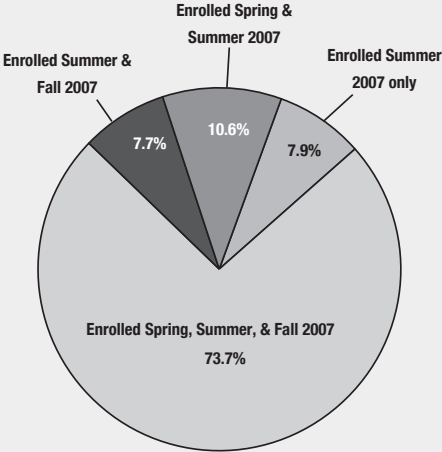

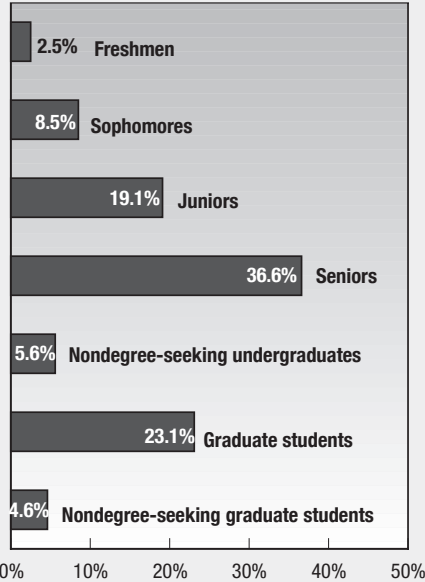

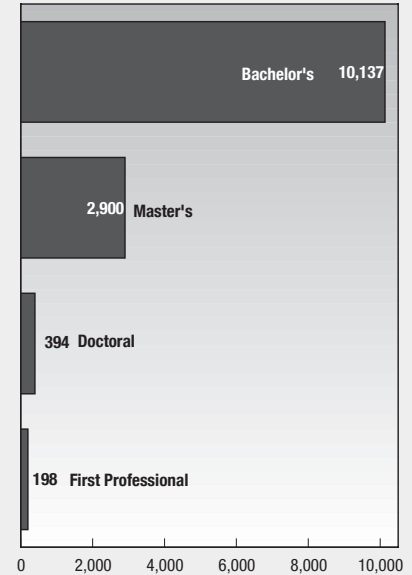

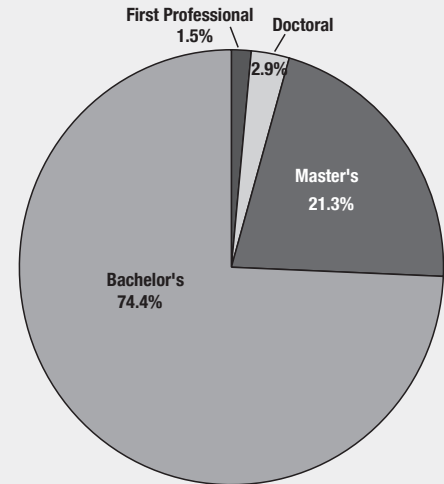

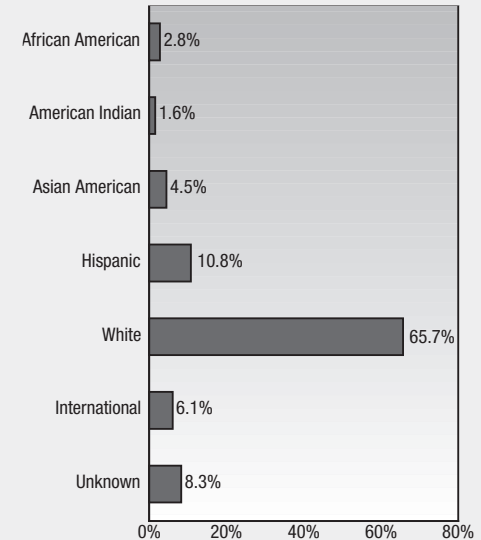
